



LASSE AND ULLA

- A documentary about lifelong love and about Alzheimer's disease

Lasse and Ulla Rudberg have known each other for 70 years. Lasse used to work as a legal expert at the Stockholm City Hall; Ulla was a school teacher. They had planned to spend their retirement in the Stockholm Archipelago, but their dream was shattered when Lasse was diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease.

The documentary covers the lives of Lasse and Ulla over nine years – a period which starts when Lasse has just been given his diagnosis and which subsequently follows his path through the various stages of Alzheimer's disease. We see how Ulla's loving care helps compensate for Lasse's shortcomings so that he can enjoy an active and meaningful life, despite his disease.
